### **Who is the Right Candidate?**

- A person who has a natural passion for protecting civil rights
- A person who has an ability to articulate a personal connection to disability
- A person who is seeking a career in emergency management
- A person who is a resident of Arizona
- A person who has reliable internet and computer access
- A person who has some previous work or volunteer experience in emergency management, public health, or public policy
- A person who is currently enrolled in a degree program at an accredited university
- A person who is able to dedicate 10-15 hours per week (*with flexibility to accommodate class schedule/ other commitments*)

The Disability Integration Specialist will serve as a mentor for the Emergency Management Intern. This internship will focus on the professional development of the intern in the field of emergency management. It is structured to provide significant work experiences and build professional relationships with key stakeholders in disability rights and emergency management. The intern will be expected to conduct an individual preparedness workshop for people who have disabilities at the upcoming 2020 Partners in Preparedness Summit.
